

## EXPANDED SRRV PROGRAM

### PERSONS QUALIFIED

1. Principal retiree applicant must be at least 40 years old
2. The legitimate spouse of the principal retiree
3. The Principal retiree's dependent child who is unmarried and under 21 years of age, must be legitimate or legally adopted
4. Applicants who are operators or workers of Philippine Offshore Gaming Operators (POGO) and/or Internet Gaming Licensees (IGL) shall be disqualified from applying for the SRRV, consistent with EO 74, s.2024, and other applicable rules and regulations.

*NOTE: In cases where such involvement is discovered after the issuance of the SRRV, the visa shall be subject to immediate cancellation.*

### SRRV OPTIONS

#### **A. SRRV CLASSIC**

#### Additional Requirements for SRRV Classic Pensioner

1. Proof of pension of USD 800.00 monthly for a single applicant and USD 1,000.00 monthly for family applicants. Documents to be submitted must be Apostilled/ Authenticated.

#### **B. SRRV COURTESY – Foreign Nationals**

#### SRRV Courtesy Option for foreign nationals includes the following:

1. Retired Diplomats from Foreign Services;
2. Retired Officers from International Organizations that are recognized by the Philippine Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) (e.g., United Nations, ADB, WB, IMF, WTO);
3. Retired Military Personnel who provided military aid and training to the Philippine Government via a defense treaty or any other similar agreement;
4. High Achievers in Academic, Business, Arts, Culture, Music, Sports, including Philanthropists.
5. For SRRV Courtesy for foreign nationals, additional documents include:
  - a) Certificate of Employment
  - b) Proof of Military Service (for retired military)
  - c) For ages 40-49 y/o, proof of monthly pension or any other similar benefits of at least USD 1,000/monthly. Documents to be submitted must be Apostilled/Authenticat

#### **C. SRRV COURTESY – Former Filipinos**

#### Additional Requirements for Former Filipinos, Any of the following:

1. Philippine Passport
2. Certificate of Naturalization
3. PSA Birth Certificate

## **BASIC DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS**

1. Passport – original, 4 photocopies (pertinent pages)
  - a. With Tourist Visa valid for at least 30 days, extendable
  - b. Tourist Visa must be convertible
  - c. 9A visa with “No Conversion” remarks and for applicant using a visa called “American, Japanese, Australian, Canadian, Schengen, Singapore or United Kingdom (AJACKSSUK visa) could not directly apply to SRRV
2. Application Form – 1 original, 4 photocopies
  - a. Typed or Computerized
  - b. Duly accomplished and bearing original signature. Write N/A for not applicable entry field
  - c. Downloadable from PRA website [www.pra.gov.ph](http://www.pra.gov.ph)
3. PRA Medical Certificate/Form, Including medical results – 1 original, 1 photocopy
  - a. Valid for 6 months upon issuance
  - b. May be secured from any hospital/clinic in the Philippines or abroad using PRA Medical Certificate/Form
  - c. If done abroad, must be Apostille or Authenticated by the Phil. Embassy/Consular Office in applicant’s country
  - d. Must be translated to English if issued in another language
4. Police Clearance or Criminal Check Record - 1 original, 2 photocopies
  - a. Applicable for Principal, Spouse and Dependents 18 y/o and above
  - b. Valid for 6 months upon issuance
  - c. Must contain “No Criminal Record” or similar findings, secured from the country of origin or last residence abroad
  - d. Must be Apostille or Authenticated by the Phil. Embassy/Consular Office in applicant’s country
  - e. Must be translated to English if issued in another language
5. Bureau of Immigration Clearance Certificate (BICC) – 1 Original, must be Clear from BI Derogatory Check
6. National Bureau of Investigation (NBI) Clearance – 1 original, 2 photocopies
  - a. Applicable only for applicants who have stayed in the Philippines for 90 days or more prior to filing the application
  - b. Information must be similar with the passport
  - c. Valid for 1 year upon issuance
  - d. Applicable for Principal, Spouse and Dependents 18 y/o and above
7. Certificate of Visa Deposit - Please refer to the SRRV Options table; (Inclusive of 3 applicants)
  - a. Must be Inwardly remitted to PRA-accredited bank. Please visit [www.pra.gov.ph](http://www.pra.gov.ph) for list of accredited banks and remittance instructions
  - b. If with Development Bank of the Philippines – see remittance instruction at the website
  - c. If with PRA Accredited Private Bank – Letter of Introduction (LOI) must be secured from the SRRV Inquiry Front Desk, then present it to the chosen accredited bank
  - d. Additional \$15,000 visa deposit for each dependent in excess of 2
8. Proof of Relationship to Principal Retiree - for Spouse and Dependent Applicants
  - a. For Dependent Spouse - Marriage Certificate or Household Register
  - b. For Dependent Child/ren – Either Birth Certificate, Household Register, Adoption document or Custody Papers issued by the Court
  - c. Must be Apostilled or Authenticated by the Phil. Embassy/Consular Office in applicant’s country
  - d. Must be translated to English if issued in another language
9. ID Photos - 8 pieces, 2x2 size, white background, no eyeglasses, taken within 3 months before joining the SRRV program
10. PRA Processing Fee of USD 1,500.00 for Principal, \$300 each dependent applicant

11. PRA Annual Fee – Please refer to table below:

| SRRV Courtesy for former Filipinos  | USD 50.00                   | Additional USD 10.00 for each additional dependent in excess of 2 |

**IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

1. Additional documents may be required depending on the SRRV Option or application circumstances.
2. All SRRV Applicants must be physically present in the Philippines for the whole duration of SRRV application process.
3. Processing Period is 30 to 45 working days from receipt of complete documentary requirements.
4. In case of Discontinuance from SRRV Application, the Processing Fee is non-refundable
